Capezio ballet pink tights #18
Black leotard
Hair must be in a bun

2. Clothing for tap, jazz, acro and lyrical

Tights not required for class.
Recital tights are Capezio #1873 in caramel color
Jazz pants, dance shorts, capris all ok
Leotards preferred but dance tops ok
Please no t-shirts, gauchos or baggy clothing
Hair must be out of face, ponytail preferred

Lyrical Shoes:

Performing company – nude color dance paws
All other lyrical classes – capezio foot undeez
Colorful patterns ok for class.
Nude color needed for recital

Jazz and Acro Shoes:

Pre-school through age 8
Capezio #205 Black Daisy ballet shoes
Ages 9 and up
Capezio E series black jazz boots

Tap Shoes:

Pre-school through age 8
Capezio black tap shoes #625, jr. tyette
Ages 9 and Up
Capezio CG17 fluid, black lace up
Capezio CG09 premiere

Clean sneakers
Baggy clothes such as sweat pants
Knee pads recommended
